Dear L'Imprimerie members,

You are invited to get involved directly in the development of your artists' centre. Join the 2020-21 program committee and get a chance to elect the next projects for La Vitrine. Together we'll keep L'Imprimerie an open, inclusive and committed workspace.

In a friendly environment, committee members will meet once every six weeks at L'Imprimerie's Salon. This committee will be constituted of a co-director, an administrator and 2-3 members. Join us and share your experience and ideas.

The committee's terms of reference

Together with the Board of Directors and top management, the program committee is responsible for L'Imprimerie's Program Policy and its implementation. In keeping with the centre's mission, values and strategic plan, this committee sets up activities, special projects and partnerships (production, distribution, publishing, mediation) to develop a strong and unique artistic vision, and to promote the centre to its target groups. It also establishes the guidelines for annual programming.

Committee members must meet the given mandate faithfully and promptly, and they must get actively involved in their chosen committees. For this reason, every new committee member has to signify his or her involvement by signing the committee's Conditions and Procedures and Mandate.

*The meetings will be held in French, but the program is both in French and English.

Role and responsibilities of committee members

Members are required to:

- Prepare appropriately for, and attend regularly to meetings;
- Perform the tasks assigned to them and carry out the necessary follow-ups;
- Respect confidentiality of the individuals;
- Not put themselves in a situation of conflict of interests;
- Respect the established decision-making process.



Priorities for the 2020-21 Program Committee

Members vow to:

- Review L'Imprimerie's Program Policy in its entirety;
- Do a follow-up on L'Écrin's second year;
- Develop the Vitrine's guidelines and plan a new edition for the summer of 2020;
- Define the residency program Customized residency project;
- Other projects will be added during the mandate.

- A letter of intent specifying your artistic vision of the printed and photographic image, explaining how you will approach it during your mandate from an interdisciplinary and professional development perspective. (500 words)
